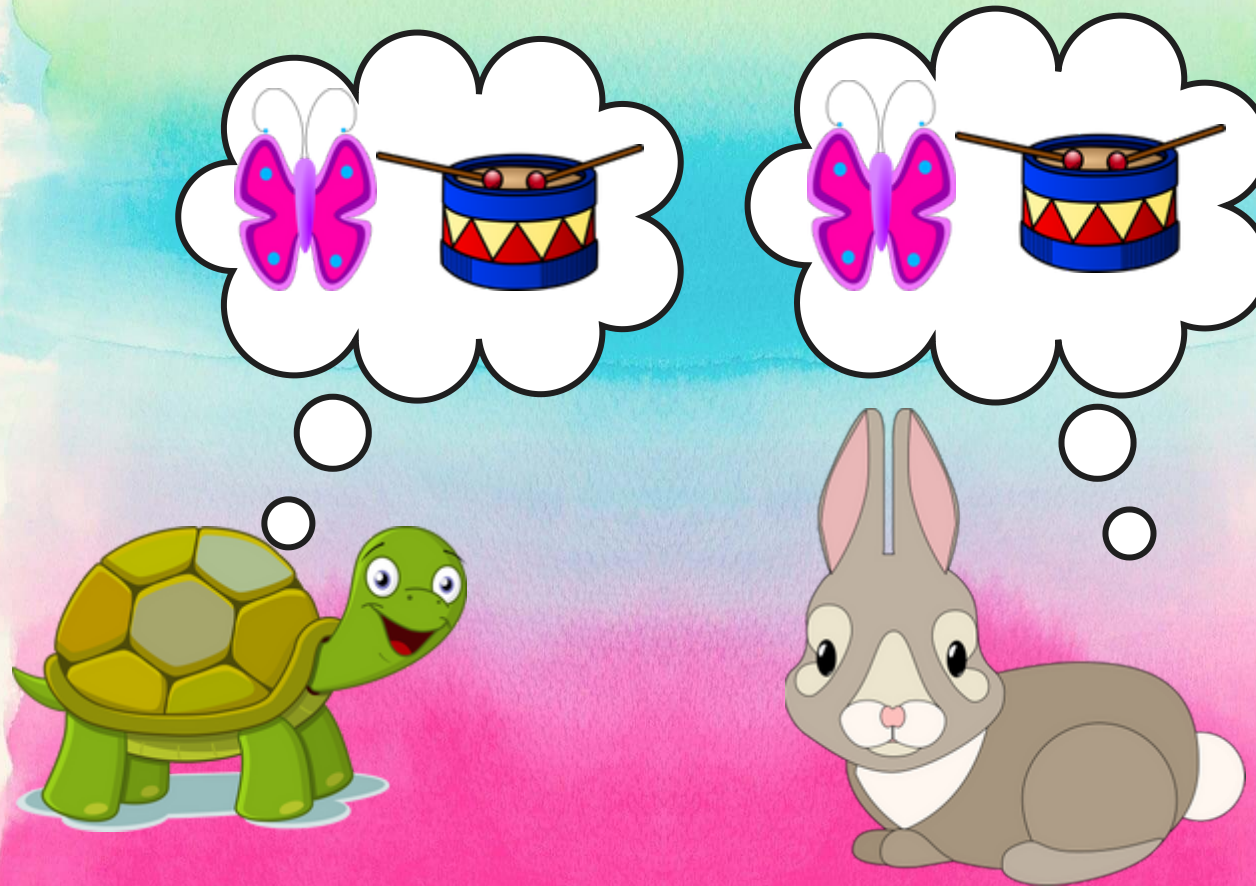


The Rabbit and Turtle's Second Race

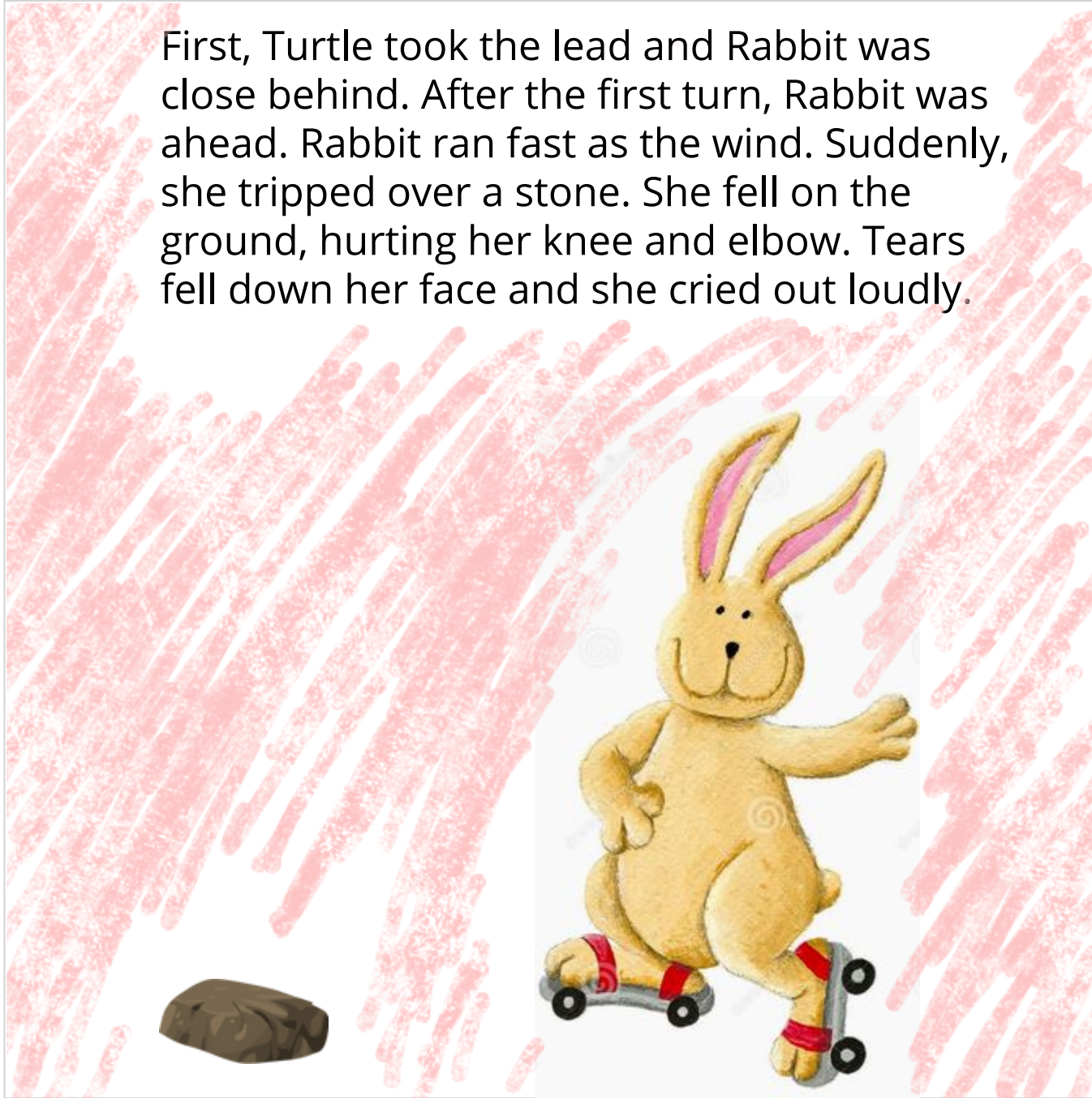
