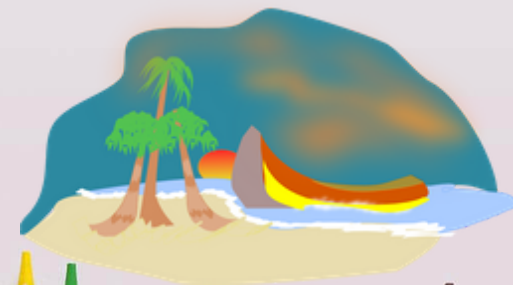
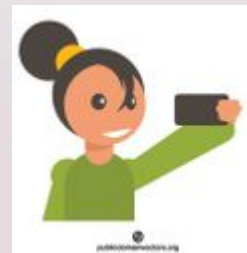
One day, class 4C and their English teacher, Miss Kung, went to the uninhabited island. When they landed, everyone cheered and jumped around.
