It is the perfect role model for students, with great manners and etiquette.

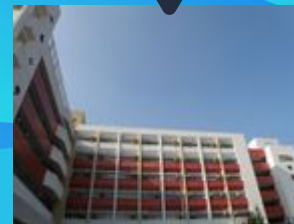


Amongus can also turn into an airplane or a car that students can travel by more conveniently.



It has a special ability —selling healthy meals to earn money. So, it can help the school raise money to improve facilities, which means more comfortable classrooms for students.

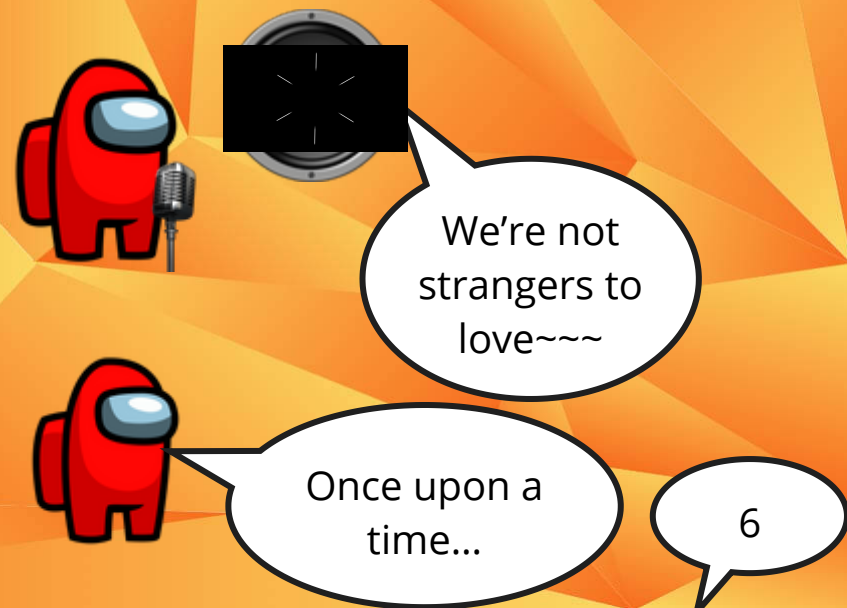
The robot can console students when they are upset and perk up their mood.



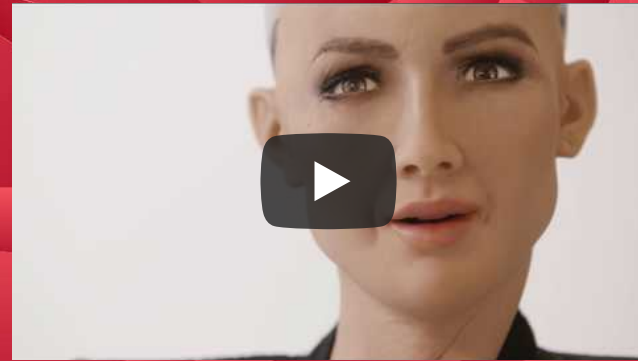

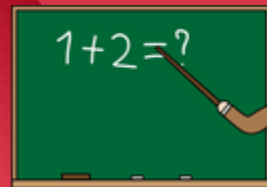
In the house, there are six bedrooms, three computer rooms, six washrooms, two living rooms, two kitchens and three dining rooms. The robot house can even play music and read audio books!
